

Obligatory Genetic Tests required by FIFe and Felis Britannica

All Breeding Cats of the following breeds must have a DNA-test for the specified genetic defect, unless both parents are proven to be free of the defect.

The cats that need testing according to this rule must be identifiable by microchip, and the results published on the pedigree or on a separate appendix to the pedigree.
